18	following schedules include the controlled substances listed or
19	to be listed by whatever official name, common or usual name,
20	chemical name, or trade name designated.
21	(1) Schedule IIn determining that a substance comes within
22	this schedule, the secretary shall find: a high potential for

abuse, no currently accepted medical use in the United States,
 and a lack of accepted safety for use under medical supervision.
 The following controlled substances are included in this
 schedule:

6 (v) Any material, compound, mixture or preparation which
