## A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for method of elections and secrecy in voting.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
6	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
8	That section 4 of Article VII be amended to read:
9	§ 4. Method of elections; secrecy in voting.
10	All elections by the citizens shall be by ballot or by such
11	other method as may be prescribed by law: Provided, That secrecy
12	in voting be preserved[.] and the right of individuals to vote
13	by secret ballot is fundamental. When Federal or State law
14	requires an election for public office or public vote on an
15	initiative or referendum or for a designation or authorization
16	of employee representation, the right of individuals to vote by
17	<u>secret ballot shall be guaranteed.</u>

1 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General 2 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the 3 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article 4 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the 5 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 6 7 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 8 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

9 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this 10 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the 11 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the 12 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 13 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 14 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 15 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of 16 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 17 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 18 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 19 primary, general or municipal election which meets the 20 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article 21 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is 22 23 passed by the General Assembly.
