AN ACT

1 Designating a portion of Pennsylvania Route 611 from the
2 intersection of Upper Barness Road and K Street (Segment
3 0040/Offset 2133) to the intersection of Park Road (Segment
4 0050/Offset 908) in Warrington Township, Bucks County, as the
5 William Bell, Sr., Memorial Highway.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. William Bell, Sr., Memorial Highway.

9 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
10 follows:

11 (1) William Bell, Sr., was a firefighter and fire police
12 captain who lost his life in the line of duty while directing
13 traffic at an accident scene near Upper Barness Road in
14 Warrington Township on January 19, 1964.

15 (2) It was reported that two vehicles were racing in the
16 southbound lanes and when the two vehicles crested the hill
17 just above the accident scene, they attempted to avoid the
18 crash and struck Mr. Bell.

19 (b) Designation.--The section of Pennsylvania Route 611 from

1 the intersection of Upper Barness Road and K Street (Segment
2 0040/Offset 2133) to the intersection of Park Road (Segment
3 0050/Offset 908) in Warrington Township, Bucks County, is
4 designated the William Bell, Sr., Memorial Highway.

5 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
6 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
7 traffic in both directions on the highway.

8 Section 2. Effective date.

9 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
