AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study, 5 providing for moment of silence on September 11 anniversary. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 10 section to read: 11 12 Section 1555. Moment of silence on September 11 anniversary. -- (a) Each school entity shall conduct a moment of 13 silence during instructional hours for students and faculty to 14 observe the anniversary of September 11, 2001, as a remembrance 15 16 of the thousands of military service persons, government employees, civilians and emergency responders who lost their 17 lives or were wounded by terrorist attacks on that date. 18

(b) The Department of Education shall make available to all <--

- 1 school entities voluntary in service training programs based
- 2 upon the moment of silence provided for under subsection (a) and
- 3 model curriculum quidelines.
- 4 (c) The Department of Education shall provide the model
- 5 <u>curriculum quidelines</u>, voluntary in-service training and any
- 6 other materials developed in accordance with this section to any
- 7 nonpublic school within this Commonwealth upon receiving a
- 8 <u>request from the nonpublic school.</u>
- 9 (B) THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL ESTABLISH A MODEL
- 10 CURRICULUM FOR INSTRUCTION IN THE EVENTS AND SIGNIFICANCE OF
- 11 SEPTEMBER 11, 2001, NO LATER THAN TWELVE (12) MONTHS AFTER THE
- 12 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION. THE MODEL CURRICULUM SHALL
- 13 INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING TOPICS
- 14 WHERE APPROPRIATE:
- 15 (1) THE HISTORICAL CONTEXT OF TERRORISM.
- 16 (2) THE TERRORIST ATTACKS ON THE WORLD TRADE CENTER, THE
- 17 PENTAGON AND UNITED AIRLINES FLIGHT 93 WHICH CRASHED IN
- 18 SHANKSVILLE, PENNSYLVANIA.
- 19 (3) AMERICAN RECOVERY AND RESPONSE TO THE ATTACKS.
- 20 (4) GLOBAL CHALLENGES AND CONSEQUENCES IN A POST-SEPTEMBER
- 21 <u>11 WORLD.</u>
- 22 (C) THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE ON THE
- 23 DEPARTMENT'S PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE CURRICULUM
- 24 MATERIALS AND OTHER AVAILABLE RESOURCES REGARDING THE EVENTS AND
- 25 SIGNIFICANCE OF SEPTEMBER 11, 2001, FOR VOLUNTARY USE BY SCHOOL
- 26 ENTITIES.
- 27 (D) NOTHING IN SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C) SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO
- 28 REQUIRE A SCHOOL ENTITY OR NONPUBLIC SCHOOL TO IMPLEMENT, ADOPT
- 29 OR USE THE CURRICULUM, MATERIALS AND OTHER RESOURCES MADE
- 30 AVAILABLE BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS SECTION.

- 1 (d) (E) For purposes of this section, the term "school" <--
- 2 <u>entity" shall mean a school district, charter school, regional</u>
- 3 <u>charter school</u>, <u>cyber charter school</u>, <u>intermediate unit or area</u>
- 4 <u>career and technical school.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
