## AN ACT

1 2	Amending Title 27 (Environmental Resources) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for emerging technologies.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Title 27 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
6	Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

12	<u>§ 4301. Definitions.</u>
13	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
14	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
15	<u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
16	"Cryptocurrency." Digital currency designed to work as a
17	medium of exchange through a computer network that is not
18	reliant on any central authority, such as a government or bank,

1	to uphold or maintain the digital currency.
2	"Department." The Department of Environmental Protection of
3	the Commonwealth.
4	"Emerging technologies." Any of the following types of
5	technologies that are used for, or are interrelated with, new
6	innovations, including, but not limited to, cryptocurrency, for
7	which the department promulgates regulations or has
8	authorization to issue permits:
9	(1) Technical innovations with progressive developments
10	within a field for competitive advantage.
11	(2) Previously distinct fields that are in some way
12	moving towards stronger interconnection and similar goals.
13	<u>§ 4302. Duties of department.</u>
14	Each application for a permit related to an emerging
15	technology shall be processed in the department's central office
16	<u>in Harrisburg.</u>
17	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
