AN ACT

- 1 Authorizing the Department of General Services, with the
- approval of the Governor, to grant and convey to the Centre
- 3 County Industrial Development Corporation certain lands and
- improvements situate in Benner Township, Centre County.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Conveyance in Benner Township, Centre County.
- 8 (a) Authorization. -- The Department of General Services, with
- 9 the approval of the Governor, is hereby authorized on behalf of
- 10 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to grant and convey the
- 11 following tract of land together with any improvements thereon,
- 12 being a portion of the lands of SCI-Rockview, situate in Benner
- 13 Township, Centre County, to the Centre County Industrial
- 14 Development Corporation for \$1,560,000, under terms and
- 15 conditions to be established in an agreement of sale.
- 16 (b) Property description. -- The property to be conveyed under
- 17 subsection (a) consists of the following:
- 18 ALL that certain part or parcel of land situate, lying and
- 19 being in the Township of Benner, County of Centre, and

- 1 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as more fully provided and shown
- 2 on that certain plan entitled, "Four lot subdivision of lands of
- 3 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the Centre County
- 4 Correctional Facility, " prepared by Sweetland Engineering &
- 5 Associates, Inc., and dated February 8, 2003, to wit:
- 6 BEGINNING at a point which is located in the right of way of
- 7 State Route 150, Benner Pike, and a point common with lands now
- 8 or formerly of the Centre County Correctional Facility; thence
- 9 along State Route 150, Benner Pike, a 150 foot wide right of
- 10 way, the following two courses and distances: 1) along a curve
- 11 to the left, having a radius 6965.55 feet, a central angle of 1°
- 12 31' 44", a chord bearing and distance of North 14° 22' 02" West,
- 13 185.86 feet, and an arch length of 185.86 feet; and 2) North 15°
- 14 07' 54" West, 348.86 feet to a point, being the northwesterly
- 15 most corner of the within lot, which is common with lands now or
- 16 formerly of GM McCrossin, Inc. (Deed Book 350, Page 919); thence
- 17 along lands now or formerly of GM McCrossin, Inc., North 46° 49'
- 18 50" East, 589.45 feet to a point, being the northeasterly most
- 19 corner of the within lot and a common corner with lands now or
- 20 formerly of GM McCrossin, Inc. and now or formerly of Gerald E.
- 21 Rogers, et. ux. (Deed Book 753, Page 884); thence along lands
- 22 now or formerly of Gerald E. Rogers, et. ux., South 47° 10' 10"
- 23 East, 1,006.15 feet to a point, being the southeasterly most
- 24 corner of the within lot and a common corner with lands now or
- 25 formerly of Gerald E. Rogers et. ux. and lasts now or formerly
- 26 of Centre County Government, specifically the Centre County
- 27 Correctional Facility; thence along lands now or formerly of the
- 28 Centre County Correctional Facility and Lot 1 of the hereinafter
- 29 identified subdivision, South 77° 05' 54" West, 1,057.29 feet to
- 30 a point and place of BEGINNING, being the southwesterly most

- 1 corner of the within lot and a point in common with the line of
- 2 State Route 150, Benner Pike.
- 3 CONTAINING 13.26-acres.
- 4 BEING identified as Lot No. 2 on a plan entitled, "4 Lot
- 5 Subdivision of Lands of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the
- 6 Centre County Correctional Facility, " prepared by Sweetland
- 7 Engineering & Associates, Inc., and dated February 8, 2003, last
- 8 revised March 31, 2003, recorded June 5, 2003, in Centre County
- 9 Plat Book Volume 68, Pages 126-127.
- BEING a portion of the same premises which became vested in
- 11 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania by deed of S. H. Hoy, et. ux.,
- 12 dated December 2, 1929, and recorded in Centre County Deed Book
- 13 142, Page 39.
- 14 ALSO BEING Centre County Tax Parcel Identifier Number 12-03-
- 15 213.
- 16 (c) Existing encumbrances. -- The conveyance shall be made
- 17 under and subject to all lawful and enforceable easements,
- 18 servitudes and rights of others, including, but not limited to,
- 19 streets, roadways and rights of any telephone, telegraph, water,
- 20 electric, gas or pipeline companies, as well as under and
- 21 subject to any lawful and enforceable estates or tenancies
- 22 vested in third persons appearing of record, for any portion of
- 23 the land or improvements erected thereon.
- 24 (d) Gaming restriction. -- The conveyance authorized under
- 25 this section shall be made under and subject to the condition,
- 26 which shall be contained in the deed of conveyance, that no
- 27 portion of the property conveyed shall be used as a licensed
- 28 facility, as defined in 4 Pa.C.S. § 1103 (relating to
- 29 definitions), or any other similar type of facility authorized
- 30 under State law. The condition shall be a covenant running with

- 1 the land and shall be binding upon the grantee, its successors
- 2 and assigns. Should the grantee, its successors or assigns,
- 3 permit any portion of the property authorized to be conveyed in
- 4 this section to be used in violation of this subsection, the
- 5 title shall immediately revert to and revest in the grantor.
- 6 (e) Easements. -- The Department of General Services may
- 7 reserve any easements in, over and across the lands to be
- 8 conveyed as it deems necessary, convenient or appropriate for
- 9 the continued operation of SCI-Rockview and/or SCI-Benner.
- 10 (f) Deed.--The conveyance shall be made by special warranty
- 11 deed to be executed by the Secretary of General Services in the
- 12 name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 13 (g) Alternate disposition. -- In the event that the conveyance
- 14 authorized under subsection (a) is not completed within two
- 15 years of the effective date of this subsection, the authority to
- 16 convey the property as set forth in this section shall expire
- 17 and the property may be disposed of in accordance with section
- 18 2405-A of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as
- 19 the Administrative Code of 1929.
- 20 (h) Proceeds. -- The proceeds from the sale shall be deposited
- 21 into the General Fund.
- 22 Section 2. Effective date.
- 23 This act shall take effect immediately.
