9	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known	
10	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a

12	Section 1529. CROSS-AGE Tutoring Program (a) The State	<
13	Board of Education shall, by regulation, establish a tutoring	
14	program whereby pupils in grades eleven and twelve may tutor	
15	pupils in grades one through six. The regulations DEPARTMENT OF	<
16	EDUCATION SHALL ESTABLISH EVIDENCE-BASED GUIDELINES FOR A CROSS-	
17	AGE TUTORING PROGRAM IN WHICH PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS IN GRADES	
18	ELEVEN AND TWELVE, UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A CERTIFIED TEACHER	

OR PARAPROFESSIONAL, MAY VOLUNTEER AS A TUTOR TO ASSIST ANOTHER

- 1 STUDENT WITH THEIR STUDIES. THE GUIDELINES shall, at a minimum,
- 2 provide for the following:
- 3 (1) The qualifications of pupils STUDENTS eligible to serve <--
- 4 as tutors.
- 5 (2) The qualifications of pupils STUDENTS eliqible for <--
- 6 tutoring.
- 7 (3) That participating tutors receive academic credits for
- 8 <u>serving as tutors.</u>
- 9 (4) That, in addition to clause (1), quidelines be <--
- 10 <u>established to WAYS TO encourage eleventh and twelfth grade</u> <--
- 11 pupils STUDENTS IN GRADES ELEVEN AND TWELVE who are not meeting <--
- 12 their academic potential BENCHMARKS to volunteer for the program <--
- 13 <u>as tutors, if it is determined that serving as tutors could</u> <--
- 14 <u>improve their own academic performance.</u>
- 15 (5) TRAINING FOR STUDENTS SERVING AS TUTORS. <--
- 16 (6) COORDINATION WITH THE CERTIFIED TEACHER OR
- 17 PARAPROFESSIONAL.
- 18 (7) STRUCTURE OF TUTORING SESSIONS FOR BOTH CONTENT AND
- 19 INSTRUCTION DELIVERY.
- 20 (8) FREQUENCY OF TUTORING SESSIONS FOR BOTH CONTENT AND
- 21 INSTRUCTION DELIVERY.
- 22 (b) This THE program shall apply to ALL PUBLIC school <--
- 23 districts ENTITIES in this Commonwealth.
- 24 (C) TUTORING SERVICES PROVIDED AS A PART OF THE PROGRAM MAY <--
- 25 NOT REPLACE OR DIMINISH SERVICES PROVIDED BY AN EMPLOYE OF A
- 26 PUBLIC SCHOOL ENTITY, BUT SHALL SERVE AS A SUPPLEMENT TO
- 27 INSTRUCTIONAL AND EDUCATIONAL SERVICES TO AID IN ENHANCING THE
- 28 ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE OF THE STUDENT TO BE TUTORED.
- 29 (D) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO:
- 30 (1) LIMIT A PUBLIC SCHOOL ENTITY'S AUTHORITY OR ABILITY TO

- 1 DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT ALTERNATIVE CROSS-AGE TUTORING PROGRAMS.
- 2 (2) SUPERSEDE OR PREEMPT THE RIGHTS, REMEDIES AND PROCEDURES
- 3 AFFORDED TO SCHOOL EMPLOYES OR LABOR ORGANIZATIONS UNDER FEDERAL
- 4 OR STATE LAW, INCLUDING THE ACT OF JULY 23, 1970 (P.L.563,
- 5 NO.195), KNOWN AS THE "PUBLIC EMPLOYE RELATIONS ACT," OR ANY
- 6 PROVISION OF A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT NEGOTIATED
- 7 BETWEEN A SCHOOL EMPLOYER AND AN EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE
- 8 EMPLOYES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE "PUBLIC EMPLOYE RELATIONS ACT."
- 9 (E) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES
- 10 SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SUBSECTION UNLESS
- 11 THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:
- 12 "CROSS-AGE TUTORING" SHALL MEAN TUTORING THAT A STUDENT IN AN
- 13 UPPER GRADE LEVEL PROVIDES TO A STUDENT IN A LOWER GRADE LEVEL.
- 14 THE TERM DOES NOT INCLUDE TUTORING THAT A STUDENT PROVIDES TO A
- 15 PEER IN THE SAME GRADE OR IN A HIGHER GRADE.
- 16 "PARAPROFESSIONAL" SHALL MEAN AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PROVIDES
- 17 SERVICES TO STUDENTS TO SUPPLEMENT AN APPROPRIATELY CERTIFIED
- 18 TEACHER IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE TEACHER'S INSTRUCTIONAL
- 19 DUTIES.
- 20 "PUBLIC SCHOOL ENTITY" SHALL MEAN A SCHOOL DISTRICT, CAREER
- 21 AND TECHNICAL SCHOOL, INTERMEDIATE UNIT, CHARTER SCHOOL,
- 22 REGIONAL CHARTER SCHOOL AND CYBER CHARTER SCHOOL.
- 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 90 days.
