1 2 3	Amending Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in development, further providing for well location restrictions.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 3215(a) and (b) of Title 58 of the
7	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
8	§ 3215. Well location restrictions.
9	(a) General ruleWells may not be drilled within 200 feet,
10	or, in the case of an unconventional gas well, [500] <u>2,500</u> feet,
11	measured horizontally from the vertical well bore to a building
12	or water well, existing when the copy of the plat is mailed as
13	required by section 3211(b) (relating to well permits) [without
14	written consent of the owner of the building or water well].
15	Unconventional gas wells may not be drilled within $[1,000]$ 2,500
16	feet measured horizontally from the vertical well bore to any
17	existing water well, surface water intake, reservoir or other
18	water supply extraction point used by a water purveyor [without

1 the written consent of the water purveyor. If consent is not 2 obtained and]. If the distance restriction would deprive the 3 owner of the oil and gas rights of the right to produce or share in the oil or gas underlying the surface tract, the well 4 operator [shall be granted] may submit a request for a variance 5 from the distance restriction [upon submission of]. As part of 6 7 the variance request, the well operator shall submit a plan 8 identifying the additional measures, facilities or practices as prescribed by the department to be employed during well site 9 10 construction, drilling and operations. [The variance] If the 11 department is satisfied that the plan adequately addresses these 12 additional measures, facilities or practices, the variance shall be granted and shall include additional terms and conditions 13 required by the department to ensure safety and protection of 14 affected persons and property, including insurance, bonding, 15 16 indemnification and technical requirements. Notwithstanding section 3211(e), if a variance request has been submitted, the 17 18 department may extend its permit review period for up to 15 days 19 upon notification to the applicant of the reasons for the 20 extension.

21 (b) Limitation.--

22 No well site may be prepared or well drilled within (1)100 feet or, in the case of an unconventional well, [300] 23 24 2,500 feet from the vertical well bore or 100 feet from the 25 edge of the well site, whichever is greater, measured 26 horizontally from any solid blue lined stream, spring or body of water as identified on the most current 7 1/2 minute 27 28 topographic quadrangle map of the United States Geological 29 Survey.

30 (2) The edge of the disturbed area associated with any 20230HB0170PN0749 - 2 -

unconventional well site must maintain a [100-foot] 2,500 <u>foot</u> setback from the edge of any solid blue lined stream,
spring or body of water as identified on the most current 7
1/2 minute topographic quadrangle map of the United States
Geological Survey.

6 (3) No unconventional well may be drilled within [300] 7 <u>2,500</u> feet of any wetlands greater than one acre in size, and 8 the edge of the disturbed area of any well site must maintain 9 a [100-foot] <u>2,500-foot</u> setback from the boundary of the 10 wetlands.

(3.1) A school, hospital, long-term care facility, 11 child-care facility or facility that houses or serves 12 individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities 13 14 shall not be within 5,000 feet of any of the following: 15 (i) A compressor station. (ii) A pit or impoundment containing drilling 16 17 cuttings, flowback water, produced water or hazardous 18 materials, chemicals or waste. 19 (iii) A tank containing hazardous materials, 20 chemicals, condensate, waste, flowback or produced water. 21 (iv) Any storage or handling of water, chemicals, 22 fuels, hazardous materials or solid waste on a well site. 23 (3.2) A building, other than that specified in paragraph 24 (3.1), water well or water supply shall not be within 2,500 25 feet of any of the following: 26 (i) A compressor station.

27 (ii) A pit or impoundment containing drilling
28 cuttings, flowback water, produced water or hazardous
29 materials, chemicals or waste.

30 <u>(iii) A tank containing hazardous materials</u>,

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1	chemicals, condensate, waste, flowback or produced water.
2	(iv) Any storage or handling of water, chemicals,
3	fuels, hazardous materials or solid waste on a well site.
4	(4) The department [shall] <u>may not</u> waive the distance
5	restrictions [upon submission of a plan identifying
6	additional measures, facilities or practices to be employed
7	during well site construction, drilling and operations
8	necessary to protect the waters of this Commonwealth. The
9	waiver, if granted, shall include additional terms and
10	conditions required by the department necessary to protect
11	the waters of this Commonwealth. Notwithstanding section
12	3211(e), if a waiver request has been submitted, the
13	department may extend its permit review period for up to 15
14	days upon notification to the applicant of the reasons for
15	the extension].
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17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
