AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in fees, further providing for exemption of
3 persons, entities and vehicles from fees.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1901(c)(16) of Title 75 of the
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1901. Exemption of persons, entities and vehicles from fees.

9 * * *

10 (c) Processing fee in lieu of registration fee.--No
11 registration fee shall be charged for vehicles registered by any
12 of the following but the department shall charge a fee of \$10 to
13 cover the costs of processing for issuing or renewing the
14 registration:

15 * * *

16 (16) [Any] (i) Subject to adjustment under subparagraph
17 (ii), a person who is retired and receiving social

1 security or other pension and whose total annual income
2 does not exceed [~~\$19,200~~] \$29,906. Unless the retired
3 person is physically or mentally incapable of driving the
4 vehicle, the retired person shall be the principal driver
5 of the vehicle but may from time to time authorize
6 another person to drive the vehicle in his or her stead.

7 (ii) Beginning the first day of January following
8 the year of the effective date of this subparagraph and
9 each January 1 thereafter, the maximum total annual
10 income amount in subparagraph (i) shall be fixed annually
11 by the department based upon the maximum amount in the
12 prior year as adjusted to reflect the change in the
13 Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for
14 the United States for all items as published by the
15 United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor
16 Statistics, for the previous 12-month period. The maximum
17 amount as adjusted shall be rounded to the nearest
18 multiple of \$1. The department shall transmit notice of
19 the new maximum amount to the Legislative Reference
20 Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.

22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in five months.
