- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 10
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1512.2. Mental Health Education. -- Each school under
- 13 the jurisdiction of the Department of Education shall
- 14 incorporate mental health education into public education
- curricula to ensure that the school's health education programs 15
- recognize the multiple dimensions of health by including mental 16
- 17 health in the relation of physical health to enhance student
- understanding, establish parity between physical and mental 18
- 19 health and eliminate the stigma surrounding mental health. The

- 1 board of school directors of each school district shall
- 2 <u>establish a mental health education curriculum to be integrated</u>
- 3 <u>within each primary and secondary school's existing health and</u>
- 4 wellness curriculum. In establishing the curriculum, a school
- 5 <u>district may consult a mental health organization to establish</u>
- 6 age-appropriate material to be taught in mental health
- 7 <u>education</u>.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
