## AN ACT

Amending the act of October 9, 2008 (P.L.1408, No.113), entitled "An act requiring scrap processors and recycling facility operators to collect certain information relating to the 3 purchase of scrap material; requiring commercial accounts; 4 and restricting scrap processors and recycling facility 5 operators from purchasing certain materials," further 7 providing for identification requirements for sale of scrap materials to scrap processors and recycling facility 8 9 operators. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. Section 3 of the act of October 9, 2008 (P.L.1408, No.113), known as the Scrap Material Theft Prevention 13 Act, is amended by adding subsections to read: 14 15 Section 3. Identification requirements for sale of scrap 16 materials to scrap processors and recycling facility 17 operators. 18 (a.1) Additional requirements for catalytic converters. -- A 19

- 1 scrap processor and recycling facility operator shall collect
- 2 the following in addition to the information required under
- 3 subsection (a) if the transaction includes a catalytic
- 4 converter:
- 5 <u>(1) The year, make, model and vehicle identification</u>
- 6 <u>number of the vehicle from which the catalytic converter was</u>
- 7 removed.
- 8 (2) A photograph of the catalytic converter.
- 9 <u>(3) A photograph of the seller.</u>
- 10 \* \* \*
- 11 (c.1) Holding period for transactions involving a catalytic
- 12 <u>converter.--If a transaction between a scrap processor and</u>
- 13 recycling facility operator and a seller includes a catalytic
- 14 converter, in addition to the requirements under subsection (c),
- 15 the following shall apply:
- (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), the scrap
- 17 <u>processor or recycling facility operator shall withhold</u>
- 18 payment to the seller for 48 hours.
- 19 (2) If a hold is in place under subsection (c), the
- 20 scrap processor or recycling facility operator shall withhold
- 21 payment until the hold is lifted by law enforcement or a
- 22 magisterial district judge under subsection (c).
- 23 (3) During a holding period under subsection (c) or this
- subsection, the scrap processor or recycling facility
- 25 operator shall keep the catalytic converter intact and safe
- from alteration, damage or commingling and shall place an
- 27 identifying tag or other suitable identification upon the
- 28 scrap metal.

- 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
