## AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in public assistance,
- further providing for personal needs allowance deduction for
- 5 medical assistance-eligible persons in nursing facilities.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 443.8 of the act of June 13, 1967
- 9 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, is amended to
- 10 read:
- 11 Section 443.8. Personal Needs Allowance Deduction for
- 12 Medical Assistance-Eligible Persons in Nursing Facilities. --
- 13 [(a)] A personal needs allowance of not less than [forty
- 14 dollars (\$40)] sixty dollars (\$60) per month, for clothing and
- 15 other personal needs, shall be deducted from a medical
- 16 assistance-eligible person's gross income, as defined by
- 17 departmental regulation, for purposes of determining the amount

- 1 that person must pay toward the cost of skilled health care and
- 2 intermediate services or intermediate care while residing in a
- 3 nursing facility.
- 4 [(b) The personal needs allowance under subsection (a) shall
- 5 be increased to not less than forty-five dollars (\$45) beginning
- 6 July 1, 2007.]
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days JANUARY 1, <--
- 8 2024.
