A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and service of Assistant Fire Chief Zachary
2 T.A. Paris, with the Community Fire Company of New Tripoli,
3 who was killed in the line of duty on December 7, 2022.

4 WHEREAS, Assistant Fire Chief Zachary T.A. Paris was born May
5 10, 1986, in Reading, and he began his career in firefighting at
6 the age of 15 when he began volunteering with the Bandon Fire
7 Company; and

8 WHEREAS, In 2010, Assistant Fire Chief Paris joined the
9 Community Fire Company of New Tripoli as a volunteer
10 firefighter, where he went on to become Assistant Chief; and

11 WHEREAS, In March 2022, Assistant Fire Chief Paris became a
12 member of recruit class 32 for the Frederick County Division of
13 Fire and Rescue in Maryland; and

14 WHEREAS, Upon graduation in September 2022, Assistant Fire
15 Chief Paris became a career Firefighter and EMT and began
16 working for the Green Valley Fire Station; and

17 WHEREAS, Assistant Fire Chief Paris served the communities of

1 Green Valley and New Tripoli since September 2022; and

2 WHEREAS, Assistant Fire Chief Paris leaves behind his wife,
3 Elizabeth, parents Gerold and Carol and two daughters, Lila and
4 Amelia; and

5 WHEREAS, Assistant Fire Chief Paris died selflessly serving
6 the people of this Commonwealth; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the Senate honor the life and service of
8 Assistant Fire Chief Zachary T.A. Paris, with the Community Fire
9 Company of New Tripoli, who was killed in the line of duty on
