1 Celebrating the life and honoring the memory of Trooper Jacques  
2 F. Rougeau Jr., who gave his life in the line of duty on June  
3 17, 2023.

4 WHEREAS, Born in San Diego, California, on September 7, 1993,  
5 Trooper Jacques F. Rougeau Jr., was the son of Angela Hunt  
6 Gervasio and her husband, Carlo; and

7 WHEREAS, A 2012 graduate of Corry Area High School, Trooper  
8 Rougeau attended Penn State Behrend before earning a bachelor's  
9 degree in criminology from The Pennsylvania State University in  
10 2015; and

11 WHEREAS, After working for Weis Markets in loss prevention  
12 for several years, Trooper Rougeau graduated from the  
13 Pennsylvania State Police Academy in 2021; and

14 WHEREAS, Originally stationed with Troop J in York, Trooper  
15 Rougeau joined Troop G in Lewistown in 2023; and

16 WHEREAS, On June 17, 2023, Trooper Rougeau was tragically

1 shot and killed by a suspect during an incident involving  
2 Pennsylvania State Police Troop G, Lewistown Station; and

3 WHEREAS, Active in his community, Trooper Rougeau was a  
4 member of the Fraternal Order of Police, and he was an avid fan  
5 of the Penn State Nittany Lions football team; and

6 WHEREAS, Trooper Rougeau also enjoyed playing golf and  
7 basketball, aviation and flying drones; and

8 WHEREAS, Trooper Rougeau faithfully endeavored to preserve  
9 and protect the health, safety and welfare of his fellow  
10 citizens and gave the ultimate sacrifice in the furtherance of  
11 these goals; and

12 WHEREAS, Trooper Rougeau demonstrated exemplary knowledge,  
13 integrity and courage in carrying out his many responsibilities  
14 and earned deep respect and gratitude for his tireless devotion  
15 to duty; therefore be it

16 RESOLVED, That the Senate celebrate the life and honor the  
17 memory of Trooper Jacques F. Rougeau Jr., who gave his life in  
18 the line of duty on June 17, 2023; and be it further

19 RESOLVED, That the Senate express heartfelt condolences to  
20 his wife of five years, Chloe Miller Rougeau; mother, Angela  
21 Hunt Gervasio; siblings, Christina Rougeau-Bailey and Justin
