## **OVERVIEW:**

House Bill 181 amends Title 34 (Game) further providing for powers and duties of enforcement officers relating to searches and for resisting or interfering with an officer.

This bill clarifies the law enforcement powers and duties of Game Commission Wildlife Conservation Officers and Deputy Conservation Officers. The legislation neither expands nor decreases the powers of Commission officers. The legislation also creates a definition for what constitutes the employment of an officer.

This legislation shall take effect in 60 days.

## **ANALYSIS:**

According to the Pennsylvania Game Commission, the adoption of House Bill 181 should have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
