**OVERVIEW:**

House Bill 281 amends Title 34 (Game) allowing the Pennsylvania Game Commission to set regulations authorizing the transfer of permits from a licensed mentor hunter to a youth hunter.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:**

The Game Commission currently has a Mentored Youth Hunting program. This bill authorizes the Commission to promulgate regulations for the program.

Adoption of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
