OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1072 as amended by A06946 provides for the Department of Corrections (DOC) to make voter registration applications available to administrators in every state correctional institution. This legislation also requires that inmates, upon release from a state correctional institution, be provided with a voter registration application.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

According to the DOC, the agency currently provides voter registration applications to inmates upon release from a state correctional institution. Because House Bill 1072 codifies existing policy, the enactment of this legislation is not expected to have an adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
