OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1472 amends the Vehicle Act (Act 84 of 1983) by allowing a licensed salesperson to sell for up to three dealers at a time.

This bill takes effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

Currently, a licensed salesperson can sell for only one dealer at a time, or for more than one facility of the facilities have the same owner. This bill removes the restrictions on a salesperson working for multiple facilities regardless of the facilities' ownership. This bill would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
