OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1671 amends Act 407 of 1963, regarding the county records committee, to provide for the appointment of a clerk of the orphan's court to the County Records Committee.

This bill will take effect 60 days after enactment.

ANALYSIS:

The proposed legislation will increase the County Records Committee membership from 15 to 16 members. There is no change in Committee duties and responsibilities. The Governor as one of his four appointments has appointed a clerk of the orphan's court. This legislation would make that a required appointment. There maybe a very minimal increase in reimbursement of expenses for one additional member. It is estimated at under \$1,000 a year which would be paid by the operating budget of the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission.

This bill has no significant fiscal impact for the Commonwealth.
