**OVERVIEW:**

House Bill 1684 appropriates funds to the Carnegie Museums of Pittsburgh for 2009/10.

This act will take effect on July 1, 2009 or immediately, whichever is later.

**ANALYSIS:**

This funding reflects the Governor's 2009/10 budget request. The bill makes the following appropriations:

- Carnegie Museum of Natural History - \$226,000
- Carnegie Science Center - \$226,000

These funding levels represent a \$25,000 decrease, or 10%, for each of these lines from the previous fiscal year of \$251,000 per appropriation.
