OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1689 appropriates \$683,000 to the Franklin Institute Science Museum for 2009/10. Payment of this appropriation shall be made by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission in equal quarterly payments.

This act shall take effect July 1, 2009, or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

This bill makes a \$683,000 State General Fund appropriation for operation and maintenance of the Franklin Institute. The amount is 10% or \$76,000 less than the appropriation for the 2008/09 fiscal year.
