OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1690 appropriates \$174,000 to the Mercer Museum in Doylestown, Pennsylvania. Payment of this appropriation shall be made by the Pennsylvania Historical and Commission in equal quarterly payments.

This act shall take effect July 1, 2009, or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

This bill makes a \$174,000 State General Fund appropriation for operation and maintenance of Mercer Museum. The amount is 10% or \$19,000 less then the appropriation made in 2008/09.
