OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1703 appropriates funds to the University of the Arts, Philadelphia for 2009/10.

This act will take effect on July 1, 2009 or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

This funding reflects the Governor's 2009/10 budget request. The bill makes one appropriation as follows:

\$1,084,000 for instruction and student aid.

This funding level represents a \$120,000 decrease, or 9.97% from the previous fiscal year.
