OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2240 authorizes the Department of General Services, with the approval of the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs and the Governor, to grant and convey two tracts of land totaling 0.51 acres of land, including the Canonsburg Armory, located in the Borough of Canonsburg, Washington County to the Borough of Canonsburg.

The bill prohibits any use of the properties for a licensed gaming facility.

In the event the conveyance authorized by this bill is not executed within two years of the effective date, the Department of General Services may find an alternative method for disposition of the land.

This act shall take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS:

The bill provides that the conveyance shall be for the fair market value of \$268,000, as determined by a June 30, 2009 appraisal. The bill further provides that all proceeds from the sale shall be deposited in the State Treasury Armory Fund.

The bill provides that all costs and fees incidental to the conveyance in this legislation shall be borne by the grantee; therefore, enactment of this legislation should have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
