## **OVERVIEW:**

House Bill 2302, Printer's Number 3438 amends the Assessors Certification Act to remove language that exempted counties of the first class from the requirements under the act. The bill will require assessors employed by the Philadelphia Board of Revision of Taxes to become certified. However, current employees of the Board of Revision of Taxes will be given a grandfather exemption.

## **ANALYSIS:**

House Bill 2302 would not have any adverse fiscal impact to the commonwealth. The Department of State has indicated that any costs to the State Board of Certified Real Estate Appraisers will be nominal, and that these costs will be offset by licensure fees.
