OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2356 amends the act of February 1, 1966, known as the Borough Code to add language concerning employment agreements with a borough manager.

The bill will take effect in sixty days.

ANALYSIS:

The bill adds language to the Borough Code stipulating that the borough manager serves at the pleasure of the borough council, subject to contractual rights from an employment agreement.

The bill also adds language regarding employment agreements with the borough manager. Agreements may last a maximum of two years and cannot run for longer than the term of the borough council. Agreements also may not guarantee employment for the term of the agreement.

The changes made by the bill to the position of borough manager will have no fiscal impact to the commonwealth.
