OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2370 amends the Public Adjuster Licensing Law of 1983. The bill adds definitions for "business entity," "business entity application," "licensee," and "nonresident public adjuster." The bill amends the act to provide for a \$200 license application fee, as well as renewal fees. In addition, the bill amends and adds numerous provisions relating to licensure of public adjusters. The legislation also amends provisions relating to penalties, fines, and license revocation.

The act shall take effect in 180 days after passage.

ANALYSIS:

The Insurance Department may incur minimal costs associated in complying with the requirements set forth in the act. As mentioned in the overview, licensure fees and renewal fees will apply, providing revenues to the commonwealth. Any costs are expected to be absorbed within the department's current operating budget.
