OVERVIEW:

This bill adds a chapter to Title 74 (Transportation), Pa.C.S., to void indemnity provisions in all future contracts for the transportation, loading, unloading, or services incidental thereof, of property by motor carriers for compensation. The provision does apply to railroads.

The effective date is sixty and only applies to contracts entered into or renewed after the effective date.

ANALYSIS:

This bill does not impact the operations or revenue of state or local governments. It has, therefore, no fiscal impact.
