OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2591 amends the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority Act further providing for definitions and for financial assistance.

House Bill 2591 provides for the following changes to the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority Act:

- Modifies the definitions of project and urban runoff;
- Storm water projects designed to manage storm water that are not considered urban runoff would now be considered a nonpoint source project and must comply with Pennsylvania's Nonpoint Source Management Program Update to receive funding;
- The provision limiting financial assistance to governmental units is removed, thus expanding eligibility to non-governmental applicants.

This act shall take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
