OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2686 amends §9730.1 (Collection of court costs, restitution and fines by private collection agency) of Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) further providing for the time that a collection agency has to collect fines, court costs, and restitution. Under this legislation, the time period for which a collection agency has to collect fines, court costs, and restitution is extended from 180 days to 48 months.

This act takes effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

The enactment of House Bill 2686 is not expected to have an adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
