OVERVIEW:

This legislation amends Title 51 by changing the composition of the Pennsylvania State Veterans' Commission, under the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs (DMVA). It proposes removal of one voting group and the addition of a replacement group.

This bill will take effect immediately upon enactment.

ANALYSIS:

The proposed legislation does not change the total members of the Commission. The legislation will remove an inactive group, the "Veterans of World War I of the United States of America, Inc." as a voting member of the Commission. Then the bill adds the "Military Officers Association of America" (MOAA) to have a voting representation on the State Veterans' Commission. The Commission meets monthly to advise and recommend actions on issues relevant to veterans. The DMVA provides the administrative support and expenses of the Commission.

This bill has no fiscal impact for the Commonwealth.
