## **OVERVIEW:**

Senate Bill 1038 is the nonpreferred appropriation for Lincoln University for 2009/10.

This bill takes effect immediately.

## **ANALYSIS:**

The bill appropriates \$13,623,000 in state funds for 2009/10 for general support. It also appropriates \$159,000 in Federal ARRA Fiscal Stabilization Funds to supplement the state amount.

In addition to the appropriations for 2009/10, the bill also contains a Federal supplemental appropriation for 2008/09 in the amount of \$830,000.
