SUMMARY: This legislation requires homeless sexual offenders and sexually violent predators to register with the state's Megan's Law list.

ANALYSIS: Sexual offenders who do not have a permanent residence will be required to register under Megan's Law with passage of this bill. Penalties are established for failure to do so. Penalties are also established for any sexual offender who fails to comply with counseling requirements. There are also criminal penalties established for sexual offenders who are required to register in another state who move into Pennsylvania and fail to register in the Commonwealth.

FISCAL IMPACT: The State Police have indicated that any additional requirements imposed by this legislation can be handled within their current operating budget. Therefore, enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
