SUMMARY: Designates the bridge crossing Marsh Creek on Business Route 15, joining Freedom Township and Cumberland Township, in Adams County, as the Wildlife Conservation Officer David L. Grove Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates the bridge crossing Marsh Creek on Business Route 15, joining Freedom Township and Cumberland Township, in Adams County, as the Wildlife Conservation Officer David L. Grove Memorial Bridge.

The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost would be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
