SUMMARY: Designates a bridge on Route 607 in Potter County as the Captain Edgar E. Nuschke Memorial Bridge and a bridge on Route 872 in Potter County as the Private First Class Edward Ritsick Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would designate the bridge which carries Route 607 over Freeman Run in the Borough of Austin, Potter County as the Captain Edgar E. Nuschke Memorial Bridge.

This legislation would also designate the bridge carrying Route 872 at Section 110, offset 0960 over the east fork of the Sinnemahoning Creek in Wharton Township, Potter County as the Private First Class Edward Ritsick Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT will be responsible for the placement and maintenance of signs displaying the designations of this bill.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
