SUMMARY: Designates the bridge carrying State Route 66/28 over Redbank Creek between Armstrong County and Clarion County as the Sergeant Joseph M. Garrison Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would designate the bridge carrying State Route 66/28 over Redbank Creek between the Borough of South Bethlehem, Armstrong County and the Borough of New Bethlehem, Clarion County as the Sergeant Joseph M. Garrison Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for the placement and maintenance of signs displaying the designation of this bill.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
