SUMMARY: Designates the bridge carrying U.S. Route 202 over the Neshaminy Creek as the First Lieutenant Travis Lemma Manion Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would designate the bridge carrying U.S. Route 202 over the Neshaminy Creek in Doylestown Township, Bucks County, as the First Lieutenant Travis Lemma Manion Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation at each end of the bridge.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
