SUMMARY: House Bill 2316 amends the Public School Code concerning intergovernmental agreements for school security and safety. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation adds a new section entitled Intergovernmental Agreements for School Security and Safety to the Public School Code. This section would allow school districts to enter into agreements with other political subdivisions to provide for the safety and security of the school. The school district may use school funds to share costs with municipalities and counties for such expenses as benefits and salaries of school resource officers and probation officers. Such officers are not required to be employees of the school district and may be employees of other political subdivisions.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
