SUMMARY: House Bill 111 amends the Public School Code concerning the powers and duties of the State Board of Education. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: Under current law the State Board of Education must adopt a master plan for higher education every five years. The plan must include eight content elements as enumerated in the School Code. This legislation would eliminate those eight elements that are currently in the School Code and replace them with five new content elements.

FISCAL IMPACT: Adoption of the legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
