SUMMARY: Designates the bridge over Washington's Landing as the William Raymond Prom Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates the bridge over Washington's Landing and the Allegheny River, which is commonly known as the 31st Street Bridge, in Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, as the William Raymond Prom Memorial Bridge.

The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
