SUMMARY: House Bill 1047, Printer's Number 1261, repeals the sunset provision for the Responsible Utility Customer Protection Act. This legislation would take effect immediately upon enactment.

ANALYSIS: This bill removes Section 5 of Act 201 of 2004, as codified in Chapter 14 of Title 66 (Public Utility Code), which repeals the December 31, 2014 sunset provision in the act. Act 201 of 2004, also known as the Responsible Utility Customer Protection Act, created the requirements governing security deposit, service termination and reconnection procedures for utilities. It also set terms and conditions for payment agreements issued by the Public Utility Commission (PUC).

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this bill will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
