SUMMARY: Authorizes new or existing municipal authorities to undertake storm water planning, management and implementation. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the "purposes and powers" section of the Municipality Authorities Act (MAA) to authorize new or existing municipal authorities to undertake storm water planning, management and implementation as defined in the articles of incorporation by the governing body. If an existing authority is already operating storm water controls as part of a combined sewer system, sanitary sewer system, or flood control project, it may continue to operate those projects without its articles of incorporation being amended.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth, municipal authority, or municipal funds.
