**SUMMARY**: Amends Title 34 (Game Code) to protect landowners who allow hunting on their land from criminal liability due to the unlawful actions of another hunter who hunts on the landowner's property.

**ANALYSIS**: SB 648 amends Title 34 Section 924 (relating to liability for actions of others) by adding a new paragraph (b)(relating to exclusions) to provide that a landowner who allows or grants permission to a person to take game or wildlife on the landowner's property shall not be liable for unlawful acts committed by that person unless the landowner willfully aids, abets, assists, attempts or conspires in the commission of the unlawful act.

This act shall take effect immediately.

**FISCAL IMPACT**: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
