SUMMARY: House Bill 835, Printer's Number 3708, makes highway, bridge and pedestrian walkway designations. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation makes the following designations:

- the section of S.R. 74 in Cumberland County from the eastern corporate limits of Carlisle Borough to the intersection with Ashland Avenue as the Marine Lance Corporal Gary Lee Ream Memorial Highway;
- a portion of S.R. 220 in Lycoming and Sullivan counties as the Lieutenant Commander John J. Peterman Memorial Highway;
- a portion of S.R. 220 in Lycoming County as the Thomas A. Paternostro Memorial Highway;
- a bridge on a portion of S.R. 74 over Sherman's Creek in Spring Township, Perry County as the PFC William Oscar Stambaugh Memorial Bridge;
- the portion of S.R. 309 between S.R. 378 and Passer Road in Upper Saucon Township, Lehigh County as the Officer David M. Petzold Memorial Highway;
- the pedestrian walkways on the Matsonford Bridge, on a portion of S.R. 3016 over the Schuylkill River, which connects the Boroughs of West Conshohocken and Conshohocken in Montgomery County as the Clay-Doc Walk in memory of West Conshohocken Borough Police Chief Joseph G. Clayborne III and Conshohocken Borough Police Chief James H. Dougherty, Sr.;
- a bridge on a portion of S.R. 4010 over Sugar Creek in Sugarcreek Borough in Venango County as the Lieutenant Andrew J. White Memorial Bridge;
- a portion of S.R. 1030 in Washington County as the Ken Griffey Sr. and Jr. Drive.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying these designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, for each dedication of a bridge, highway or pedestrian walkway costs \$500. These costs can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
