SUMMARY: Senate Bill 1235, Printer's Number 2162, reauthorizes the Underground Utility Line Protection Law for one year.

ANALYSIS: This bill amends the Underground Utility Line Protection Law (Act 287 of 1974) to extend the effective date of the law one additional year from December 31, 2016 to December 31, 2017. Extending the sunset of this law will allow the Department of Labor and Industry to continue enforcing the provisions of the law.

This legislation would take effect immediately upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
