### SUMMARY:

House Bill 105, Printer's Number 1573, amends the Telemarketer Registration Act to prohibit telephone solicitations on legal holidays and provide for robocall requirements related to opt-out procedures.

### ANALYSIS:

This bill amends the Telemarketer Registration Act (Act 147 of 1996) to prohibit making a telephone solicitation call on a legal holiday and provide for robocall requirements. The bill defines "robocall" as a telephone solicitation call made to a large number of people, using a computerized autodialer, to deliver a prerecorded telemarketing message, and prohibits such calls to those persons on the "do-not-call" list.

It also requires that the listing of a telephone number on the "do-not-call" list be maintained until such time as the number is no longer valid for the subscriber or the subscriber requests to have the telephone number removed from the list.

This shall take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this bill will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
