SUMMARY: Designates a bridge on a portion of S.R. 1005 over Beaver Creek in Bedford County as the PFC/POW William G. Koontz Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a bridge on a portion of S.R. 1005, known as Church View Road, Segment 0180, Offset 0000, over Beaver Creek in South Woodbury Township, Bedford County as the PFC/POW William G. Koontz Memorial Bridge.

PFC Koontz served in the US Army in South Korea during the Korean War, and endured 888 days in brutal conditions at Chong-song prison camp in North Korea.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
