SUMMARY: House Bill 196, Printer's Number 162, provides employment protections to Pennsylvania residents who are members of a National Guard or Reserve unit in another state.

ANALYSIS: This bill amends Section 7309 of Title 51 (Military Affairs) by inserting subsection (d.1) to apply employment discrimination protections to out-of-state Pennsylvania National Guard members. It states that "this section shall also apply to an individual who is a member of a National Guard or reserve component from another state."

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
