SUMMARY: House Bill 220, Printer's Number 187, amends Article XXIII-A, Powers and Duties of the Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs, Section 2301-A of the Administrative Code regarding admission to drug and alcohol treatment facilities. This legislation is effective in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation requires that the Department of Drug and Alcohol Program's standards for treatment and rehabilitation facilities prohibit a facility from denying addiction treatment to an individual solely on the basis of a negative drug test.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. The Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs does not currently require a positive drug test for an individual to receive treatment.
