SUMMARY: Repeals Act 49 of 1933 which prohibits baseball or football games on Sundays before 2:00pm or after 6:00pm in certain circumstances. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would repeal Act 49 of 1933. Act 49 currently prohibits any person, co-partnership, association, or corporation to conduct, stage or engage in any baseball or football game on Sundays before 2:00pm or after 6:00pm unless the voters in the municipality have voted in favor of baseball and football on Sunday and have a license from the proper municipal authorities between those hours on Sunday. If the vote of the electors in the municipality is not in favor of baseball and football, then no ordinance or resolution providing for the licensing of baseball and football games can be enacted or adopted.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or municipal funds.
